The Mosaic Project

The Miles of Tiles Mosaic is just one of many examples of our unique, hands-on approach to inspire unity and collaboration amongst hospital and healthcare teams.

The “Caregivers Tree” is the collective work of over 600 hospital team members, all of whom participated in one of 16 staff retreats held over a period of four months. At the end of each day, participants were partnered 2:2 and directed to glue their tiles to a small piece of canvass spattered with paint colors. They were given limited direction, and empowered to use their imagination, collaboration and communication tools introduced throughout the retreat experience.

Without having an image of the final design; even the skeptics in the room believed that the project would come into focus. Soon after the retreats concluded, The Impact! art design team installed the mosaic with support and assistance from the hospital’s facilities team.

Today, the 12’ x 6’ Caregivers Tree Mosaic floats on a wall in the East Lobby Corridor of Columbia Memorial Hospital in Astoria, Oregon. It serves as a constant reinforcement of the power of trust and teamwork and enhances the patient-centered, healing environment.
